CMA provides leadership trainings and equips local pastors and church leaders from least-reached, underdeveloped areas with knowledge and skills for effective ministry. The pastors are also provided with Bibles, and given mobility through bicycles and motorcycles.

## The Girls Rescue Center Highlights for 2023

**16** more girls rescued

**39** girls in secondary school

**53** girls resident at the Center

**12** girls graduated from secondary school

**16** girls in primary school

**5** girls graduated from primary school

**22** girls in college



**God's Word Every Child: 154** teachers trained & **12,840** books distributed to primary & Sunday school children

A total of **107** students, including **18** primary school students, **65** secondary school graduates, and **24** college students, received sponsorship.

# Community Development

## Community Development Ministry: CMA

promotes community-driven approach that empowers leaders to use their God-given abilities to create sustainable development in their own communities to successfully overcome their needs and challenges.



**Water filters:** Water filters are an effective solution for providing access to clean drinking water and reducing water-borne diseases in marginalized communities. CMA is committed to successful implementation that requires proper education on filter use/maintenance and cultural acceptance. **Over 2,000 water filter kits** were distributed to families in Maasailand and the urban slums.

## Uganda Orisai Irrigation Project: Providing food for an entire community

The flourishing 22-acre irrigation project continues to provide nourishment for the community, including the 350 students at Grace Junior School. By utilizing the lake water, this resourceful project ensures year-round cultivation of corn, onions, amaranth, and sweet potatoes.

Not only does the harvest provide ample food for the community, but the surplus is sold to generate income. This income, in turn, is reinvested in farm inputs, guaranteeing the project's long-term success. This innovative approach to irrigation is a model for other communities seeking to achieve food security and economic empowerment.

CMA provides quick and appropriate emergency relief and care to victims of natural and man-made disasters reaching many families that lack basic needs in Kenya and Uganda, and providing emergency medical and nutritional services in war-torn South Sudan. CMA is a leading organization in nutrition and medical interventions in South Sudan.

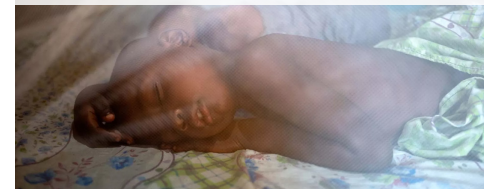
